

INTRUDER ALARM

An intruder alarm is a system that is designed to deter and detect unwanted visitors into a building/area. It is commonly made up of components that cover doors, movement and vibration.

This can be a local audible/visual notification or an alert to a reponsible person or to the services.

What is included in our Intruder Alarm Maintenance?

During Intruder Alarm Maintenance, the following checks will be completed:

- A visual inspection of all components of the system, including sensors, control panels, wiring and peripherals to check for any signs of damage, wear or tampering.
- A functional test will be carried out on each of the components to check the alarm system is functioning correctly. This will include testing individual sensors, checking communication pathways, verifying alarm signals and testing the overall system response.
- We will carry out a full battery check to ensure continued operation during power outages.
- If the alarm includes software or firmware components, there may need to be a software
 update carried out within the maintenance to ensure the system is equipped with the latest
 features, bug fixes and security patches.
- A detailed report will be carried out of the maintenance activities performed, any issues detected and actions taken to address them.

How often should you carry out Intruder Alarm Maintenance?

The frequency of intruder alarm maintenance depends on various factors, including the type of system, its age, the environment and any regulatory requirements.

As a general guide, it is recommended to have an intruder alarm system maintained and inspected at least once a year. However, some systems may require more frequent maintenance if they are situated within high risk environments.

It is always advised to follow the manufacturer's recommendations and any regulations/guidelines to determine the appriopriate maintenance schedule.
